PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

INAPRO® HS-MSO is a highly concentrated blend of quality methylated soybean oil and surfactant blend. This concentrated formula can be used at reduced rates to traditional methylated seed oil. INAPRO® HS-MSO is specifically designed to benefit many pesticide applications with a high-content blend of innovative and patent-pending diffunctional, long-chain amine oxide surfactants.

INAPRO® HS-MSO contains humectant qualities as well as superior penetration performance provided by buffered amine oxide technology to improve the effectiveness of systemic and contact herbicides. When used as directed, INAPRO® HS-MSO maximizes certain pesticides; always read and follow label recommendations, and take special care with sensitive crops during periods of drought stress, high temperatures or high humidity.

RATE RECOMMENDATIONS

If the herbicide recommends 1 pt/A, use 0.5 pt/A to 0.75 pt/A.

If the herbicide recommends 1 gt/A, use 1 pt/A.

Or use 1.5 to 3 quarts per 100 gallons (minimum 8oz/A). You can reduce rates by 25% under ideal growing conditions (minimum 8 oz/A).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Start with a clean spray tank. INAPRO® HS-MSO should be added to the tank accordingly to mixing order recommended on the pesticide product label. Agitate while mixing and during spraying. Generally, add product after pesticides have been added and thoroughly mixed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep containers sealed when not in use. Store in original container only. Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal. The Agricultural Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates the national recycling program.
